Ramesh, Chairman, Deloitte Haskins & Sells LLP.

The Chief Guest of the evening, Mr. Ravi Venkatesan, Chairman, Bank of Baroda, Former MD, Microsoft India presented the awards. Moderated by Mr. Shailesh Haribhakti, the ceremony was followed with a panel discussion on "The Looming Global Wars for Clean Air and Water" with the all the awardees. The highlight of the discussion was also about the need for including Ethics in the management education curriculum to infuse ethical decision-making in the generation next early on in their careers.

Dr. Ms. Karuna Jain – Director, NITIE, Prof. Hema Date – Dean (Student Activities) and Prof. Ravindra Gokhale received the award on behalf of NITIE.
